BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

These rules would reduce sulfur dioxide (SO₂) emissions in the nonattainment area in Wayne County as designated by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). The purpose of these rules is to bring this area of the state into attainment with the EPA's National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS). These SO₂ emissions limitations would apply directly to US Steel, Great Lakes Works.
