BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Current rules apply to electric service utilities under the jurisdiction of the Michigan Public Service Commission (MPSC), and intend to promote safe and adequate electric service, encourage safety and efficiency, and provide for standards for uniform and reasonable electric utility practices. The proposed rule changes would update technical standards for electric service to reflect advances in metering technology, remove references to obsolete equipment, and include provisions for cybersecurity and reporting practices.

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES

2017-091 LR would not have a significant fiscal impact on any unit of state or local government. Any cost incurred by the MPSC would be sufficiently supported by existing departmental appropriations.

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
