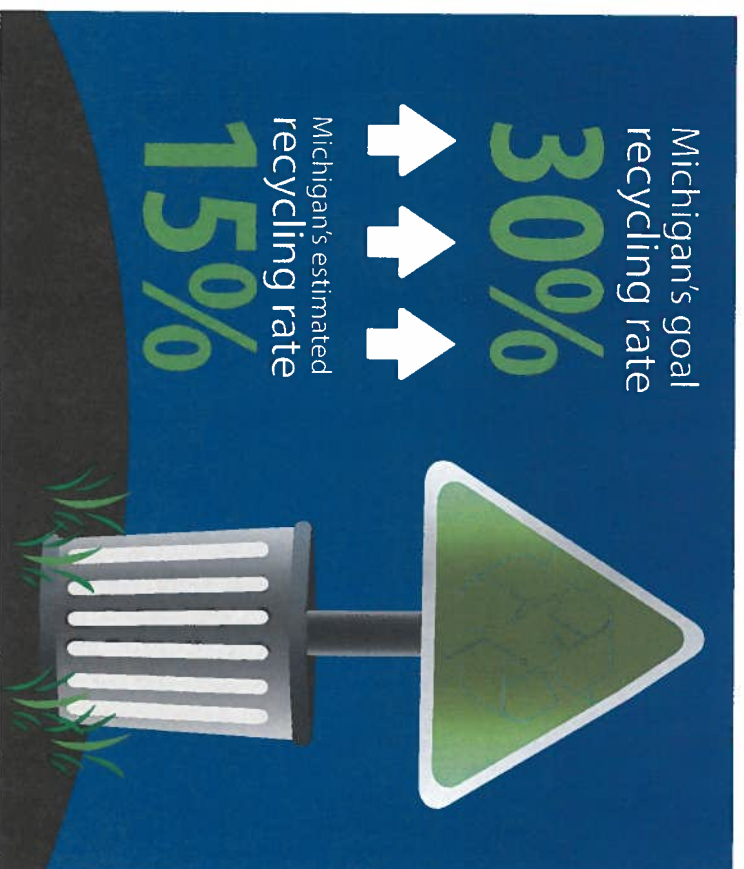

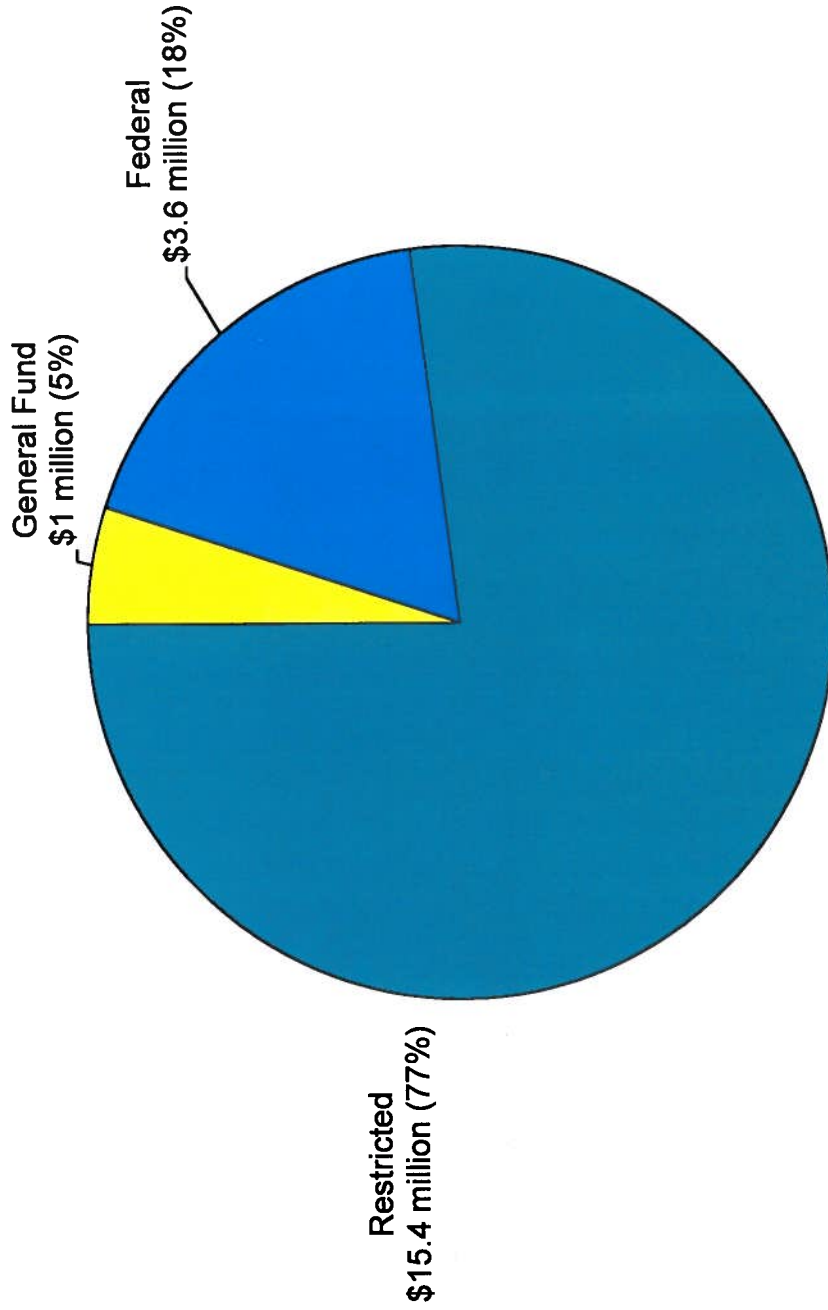

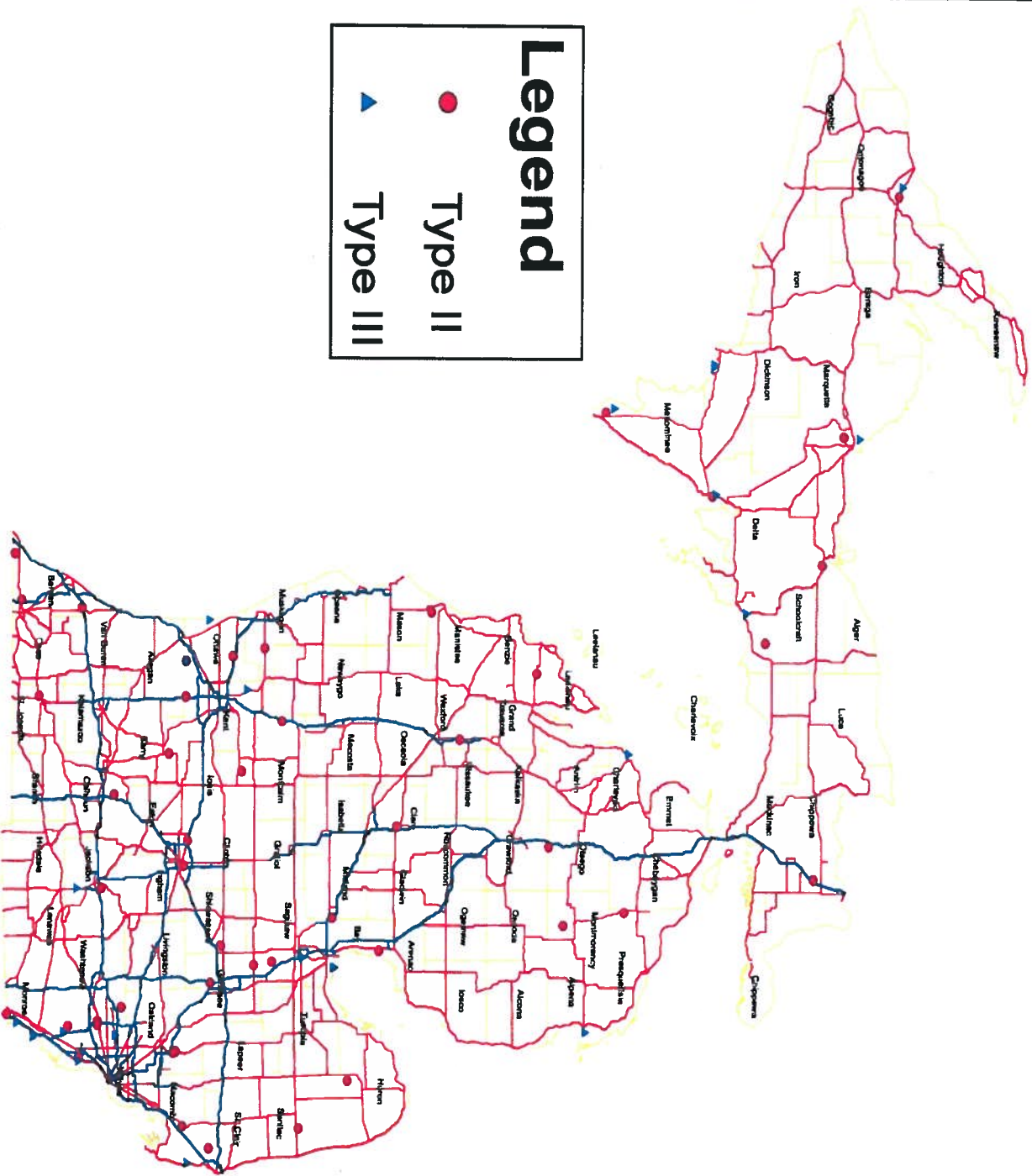
- Solid Waste Surcharge
- Scrap Tire Fee
- Electronics Registration Fees



Solid Waste Surcharge

- 36¢/ton solid waste disposed in landfill
- Fee range neighboring states: 50¢ to \$13/ton
- Paid by waste haulers (gate fee)
- Supports review of landfill plans and siting, and beneficial use
- Protects public health and the environment

Scrap Tire Fee

- Owners of vehicles registered under the Michigan Vehicle Code
- \$1.50 per application for certificate of title
- Supports oversight of scrap tire collection and grants for cleanups and market development
- Last increased in 2002

Electronics Registration Fees

- E-waste manufacturers pay \$3,000 annually
- E-waste recyclers pay \$2,000 annually
- Supports development of takeback programs for TVs, computers, and printers
- Promotes recycling and proper disposal of e-waste
