## BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Rule Set 2022-30 LR would make numerous amendments to rules pertaining to chiropractic profession. Specifically, the rule set would accomplish the following:

- Adopt by reference accreditation standards for chiropractic educational programs.
- Organizational and typographic revisions.
- Revise the requirements for licensure by endorsement and relicensure.
- Clarify the period when a licensee may request a waiver of continuing education.
- Revise continuing education requirements.

## FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES

2022-30 LR is not anticipated to affect the expenditures or revenues of any state or local government units.
