BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

The proposed rules would add standards for per and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) levels in drinking water and groundwater. These standards would supplement the department's water testing procedures for the presence of PFAS.

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES

It is unlikely that the proposed rules would affect costs or revenue for EGLE. These changes are also unlikely to affect costs or revenues for local units of government.
