BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

The federal government through the Environmental Protection Agency allows for the Hazardous Waste Management Program to be administered in Michigan by the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE). The department must maintain administrative rules in accordance with EPA standards. These proposed revisions would allow EGLE to remain in compliance with these standards and prevent duplicate or contradictory regulations.

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES

The department estimates that the proposed rule changes will reduce revenue from hazardous waste fees by \$80,000. The proposed changes are equally likely to reduce departmental costs by exempting certain material from hazardous waste regulatory requirements. These changes are also unlikely to affect costs or revenues for local units of government.
