BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Rule Set 2022-23 LR would make numerous additions and recissions to rules pertaining to landscape architects, principally to reorganize and renumber existing rules to comply with drafting requirements and to improve organization. The rule set would also update educational accreditation standards and establish a procedure for requesting a waiver of continuing education requirements.
