BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Rule Set 2021-54 LR would make numerous amendments to rules pertaining to the osteopathic medical profession. Specifically, the revisions would update accreditation standards for osteopathic medical schools and residency programs, incorporate legislative changes for licensure by endorsement, clarify eligibility pathways, update relicensure pathways, and remove continuing education activities that are no longer relevant.

2021-54 LR would not have a fiscal impact on the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs or any other state or local government units.
