BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Rule Set 2020-131 LR would make numerous additions and amendments to rules pertaining to unarmed combat sports in Michigan. Specific changes accomplished by the rule set would include, but are not limited to, establishing safety standards, procedures, and a regulatory process to allow for kickboxing and Muay Thai events; including language regarding the impartiality of event officials; establishing a minimum purse amount for professional unarmed combat sports; revising licensure requirements; and creating an atomweight class.
