#### **BUREAU OF HEALTH CARE SERVICES**

- Bureau of Health Care Services (BHCS) employs 1,473 health care staff
- Staff include health care, mental health, dental and substance abuse
- Clinic staff include medical and psychiatric providers, nurses/nurse managers, dentists, qualified mental health professionals (social workers and psychologists), pharmacy assistants, and clerical support staff
- BHCS also employs some specialized positions at Duane Waters Health Center (DHWC), Women's Huron Valley Correctional Facility (WHV) and Woodland Correctional Facility (WCC)
  - Positions include: Resident Care Aide (RCA), Laboratory Assistant, Medical Technician, Occupational Therapist, Respiratory Therapy Technician and Phlebotomist

## **IMPACT OF STAFF VACANCIES**

- Due to nursing vacancies a wing at DWHC has been consolidated.
  - DWHC is an inpatient facility with 152 beds
  - Currently, 34 beds cannot be used due to nurse vacancies
- Vacancies have impacted the Department's ability to provide nightly nursing coverage at 10 facilities (JCS, SMT, NCF, ECF, SRF, DRF, IBC, ICF, RMI, MTU)
- Nursing staff are being mandated to work overtime to adequately cover clinic shifts

# **VACANCIES- NURSING**

- Nursing vacancies in the Department's ambulatory clinics (statewide)
- There are 50 RN and 13 LPN contractual staff filling about 69% of the current nursing vacancies.

#### **VACANCIES – DENTISTS**

- There are currently 22 dental vacancies out of 35 positions.
  - A total of 20 of those vacancies are covered by contractors
  - The current maximum hourly rate for a Civil Service Dentist is \$60.51 plus benefits, and the contractual hourly rate is \$140.
  - In order to attract dentists the Department needs to pay a higher rate of pay.

# RECRUITMENT CHALLENGES/STRATEGY

- Recruitment challenges facing the MDOC include:
  - Non-competitive salaries
  - Location of some of the positions
  - Work environment
  - Work hours/flexibility
  - Competing with hospitals, doctor offices, etc.
