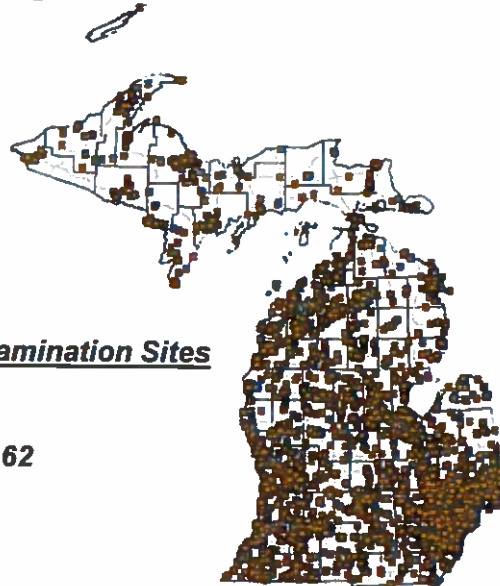

Michigan's Environmental Contamination Open Sites

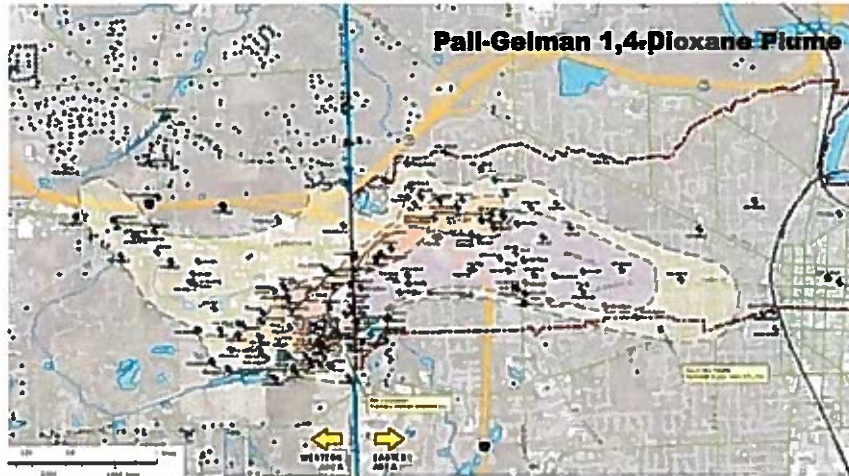

Response Activities - Protect Drinking Water

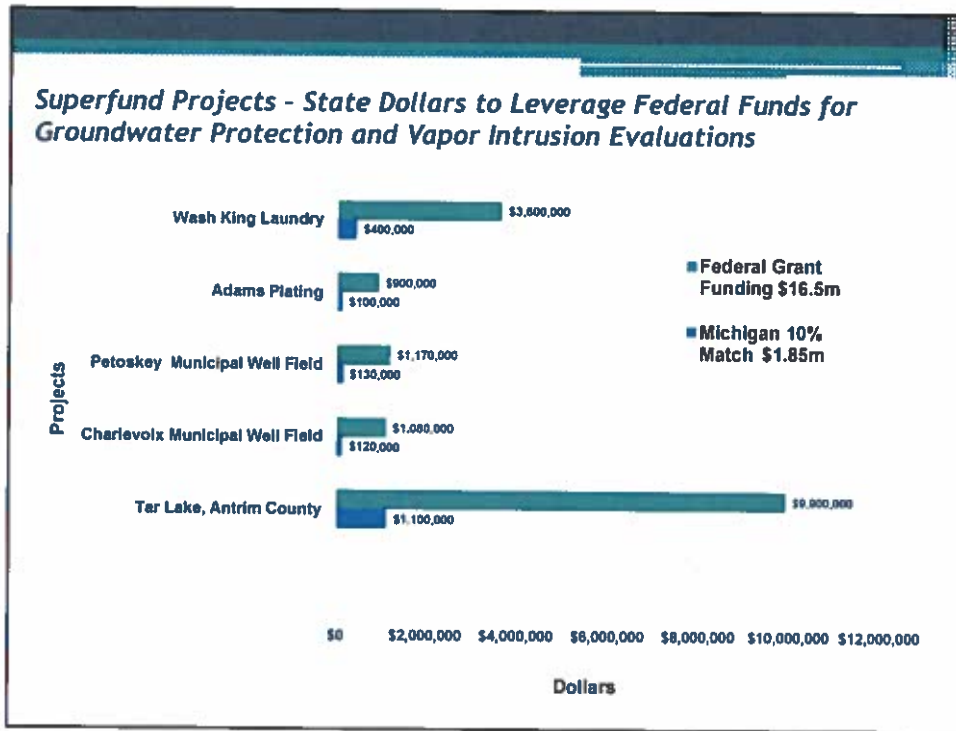

FY 17 Appropriations: Budget Request Summary

- \$16.4 million of CMI Funds to address thirteen high priority sites; the funds will leverage \$16.6 million of federal funds; and to address contaminated sediments in lakes and rivers.
- \$1.5 million of RPF Funds to address eleven LUST sites.
- All requested funds to be spent on cleanup actions.
