# **FISCAL SNAPSHOT**

## THE FOUNDATION ALLOWANCE

#### Date: January 2023

#### Summary

The foundation allowance is a per-pupil funding amount, created as part of the Proposal A school finance reforms, that pays for the bulk of districts' operations.<sup>1</sup>

Initially, in fiscal year (FY) 1994-95, districts received between \$4,200 and \$6,500 per pupil. In FY 2021-22, the gap between the foundations was closed and all non–Hold Harmless districts were set at the Target foundation allowance, which was \$8,700 per pupil.

For FY 2022-23, the Target foundation allowance is increased to \$9,150 per pupil.



#### Foundation Allowance History: Growth Since Proposal A


#### State/Local Funding Mix

Generally, each district is expected to levy 18 mills on non-homestead property to make up the local piece of their foundation allowance. The state deducts the district's per-pupil local revenue from the Target foundation allowance to determine the district's amount of state funding per pupil. Regardless of a district's state and local funding breakout, each district receives an amount equal to the Target foundation allowance multiplied by the district's pupil count.

#### Hold Harmless and Out-of-Formula Districts

Districts with foundation allowances above the Target (due to high state and local revenue before Proposal A was implemented), called *Hold Harmless* districts, are allowed to levy additional local mills with voter approval to achieve their statutory foundation allowance. Districts for which local revenue exceeds their foundation allowance, known as *Out-of-Formula* districts, do not receive a state share and may keep the local revenue that exceeds their statutory foundation allowance.
