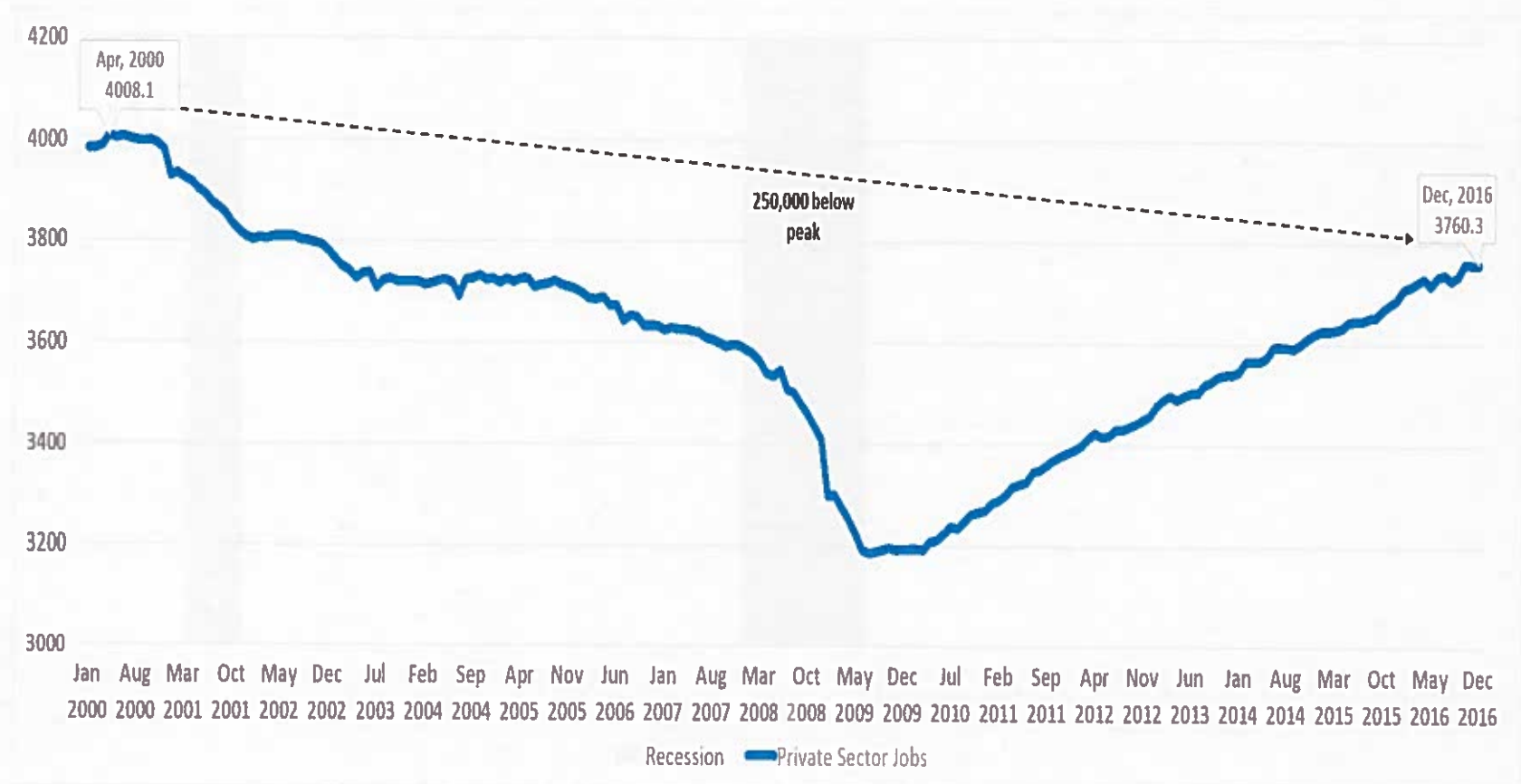

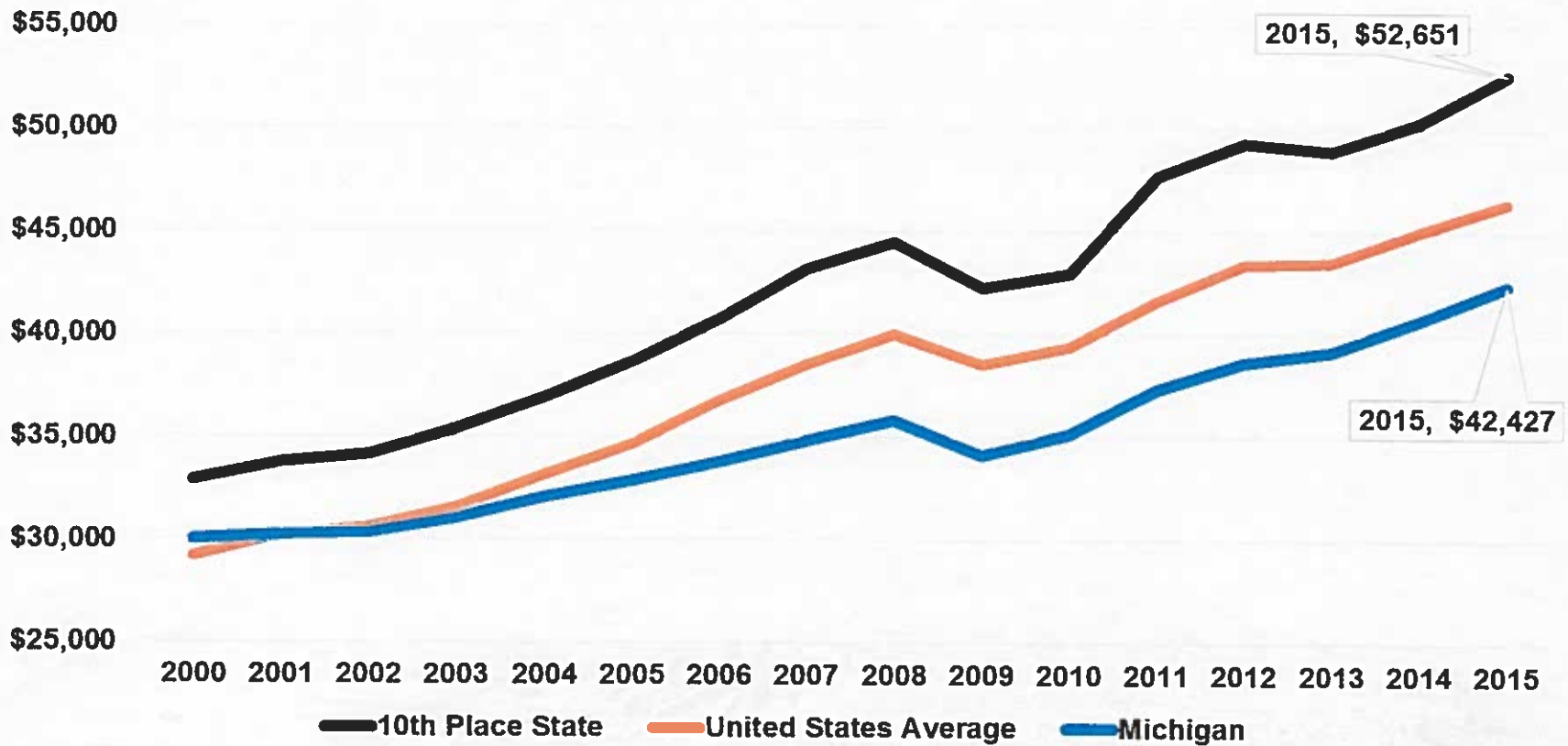

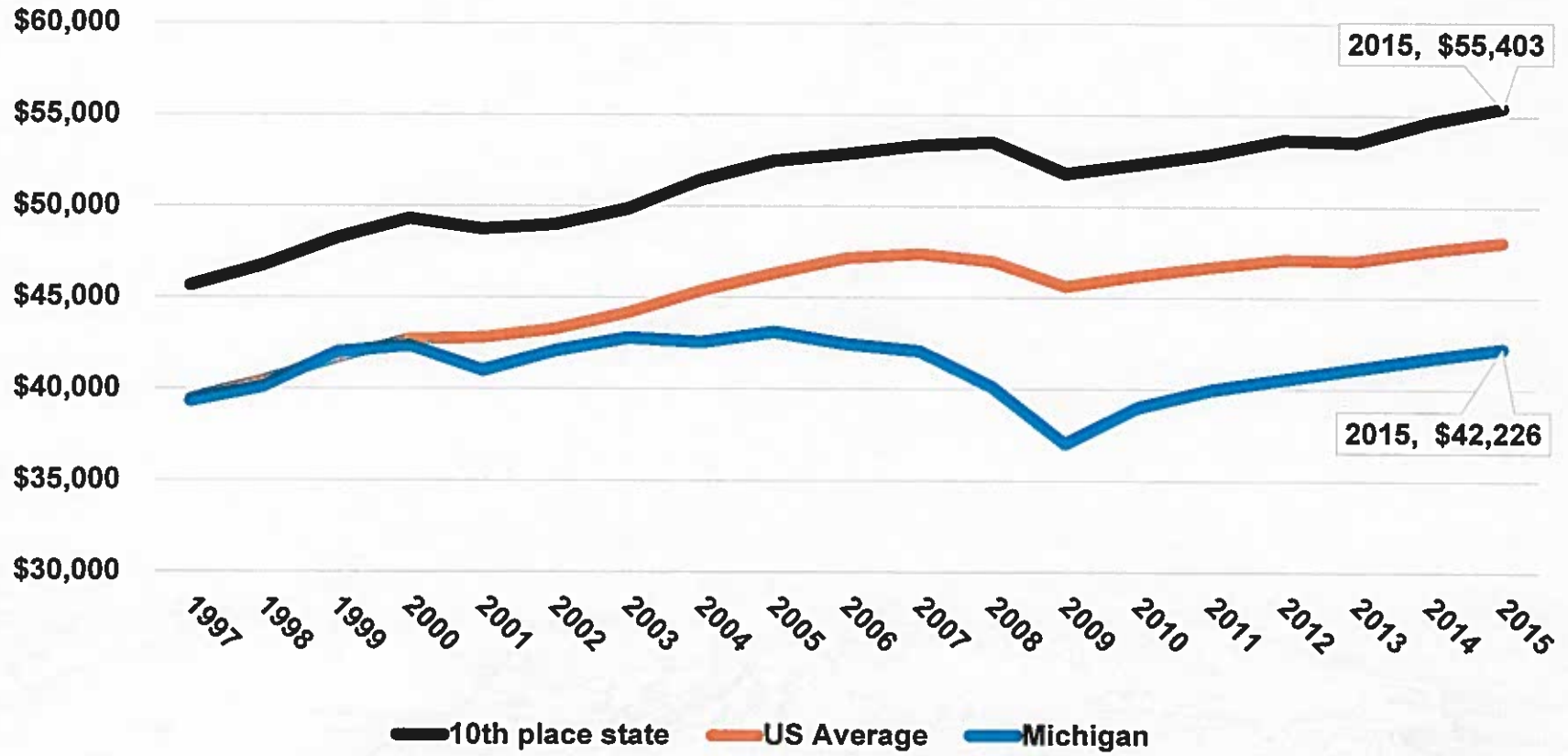
OUTPUTS: EMPLOYMENT STRONG IMPROVEMENT



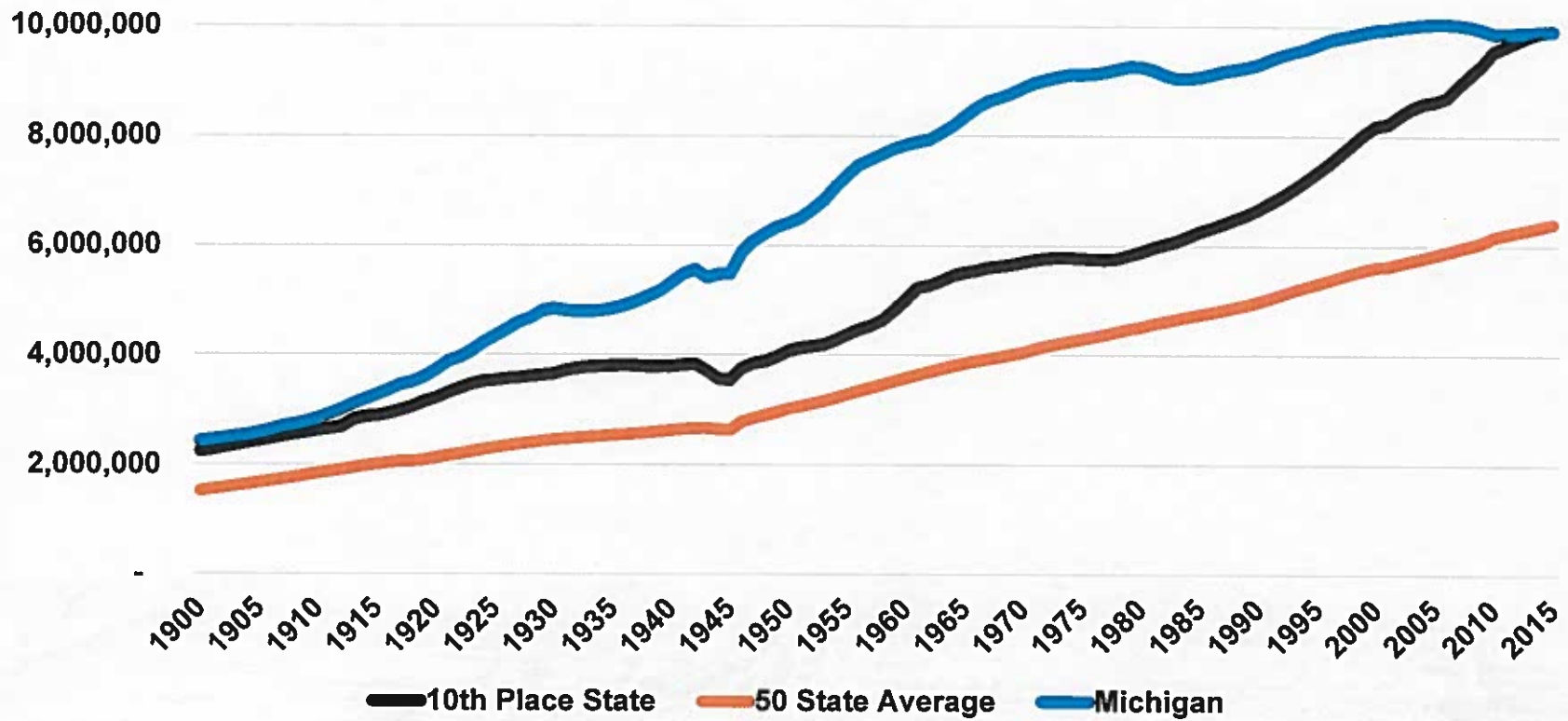
OUTPUTS: PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME IMPROVING, OFF LOW BASE



OUTPUTS: PER CAPITA GDP IMPROVING, OFF LOW BASE

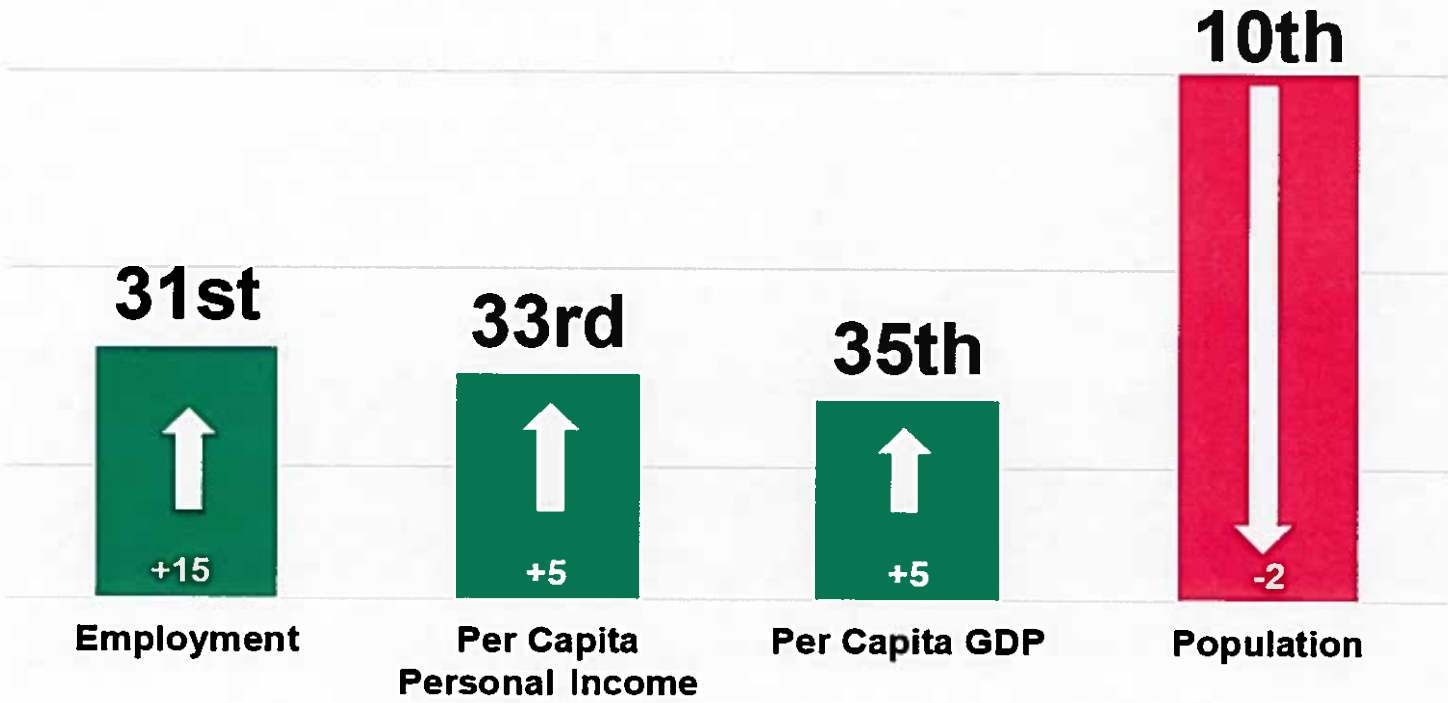

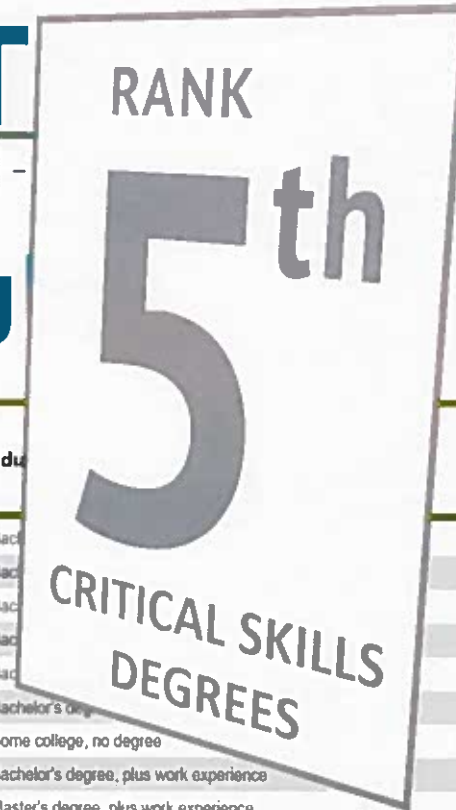

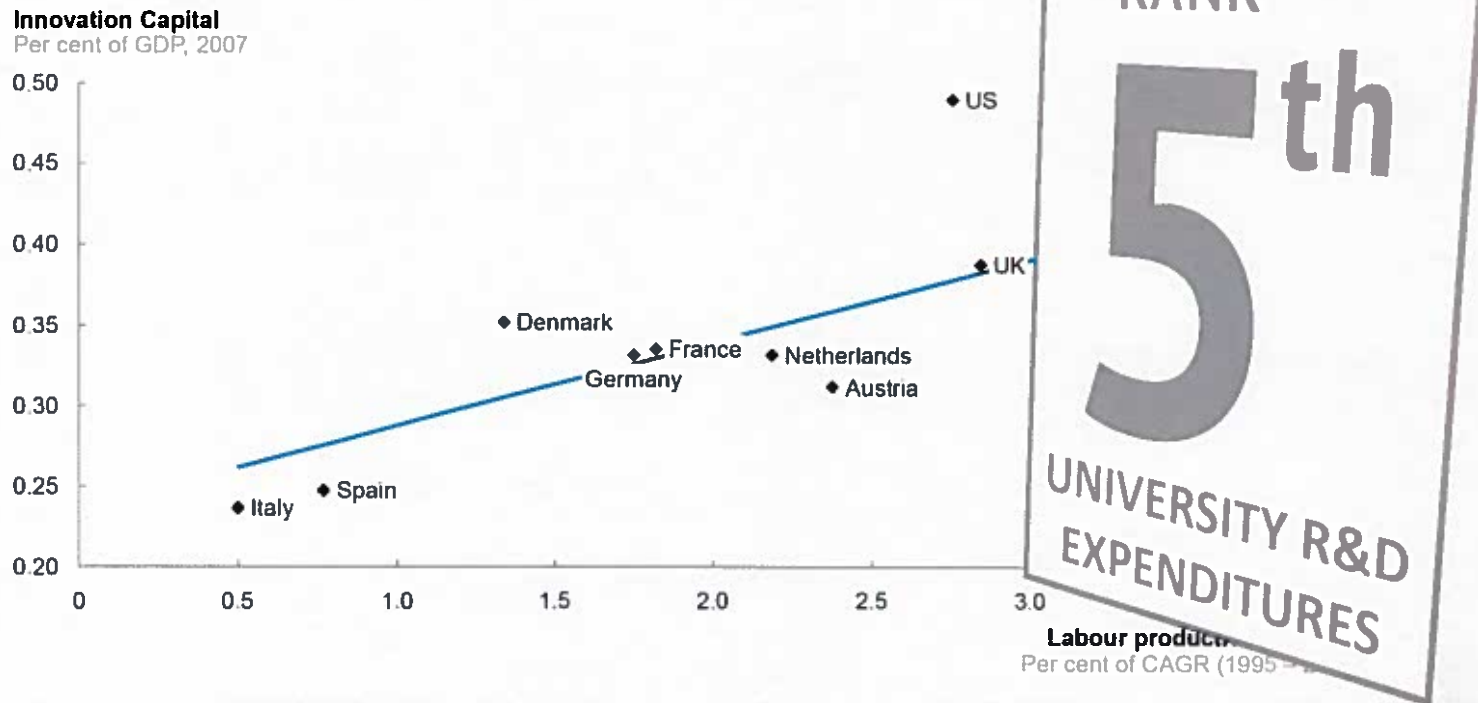

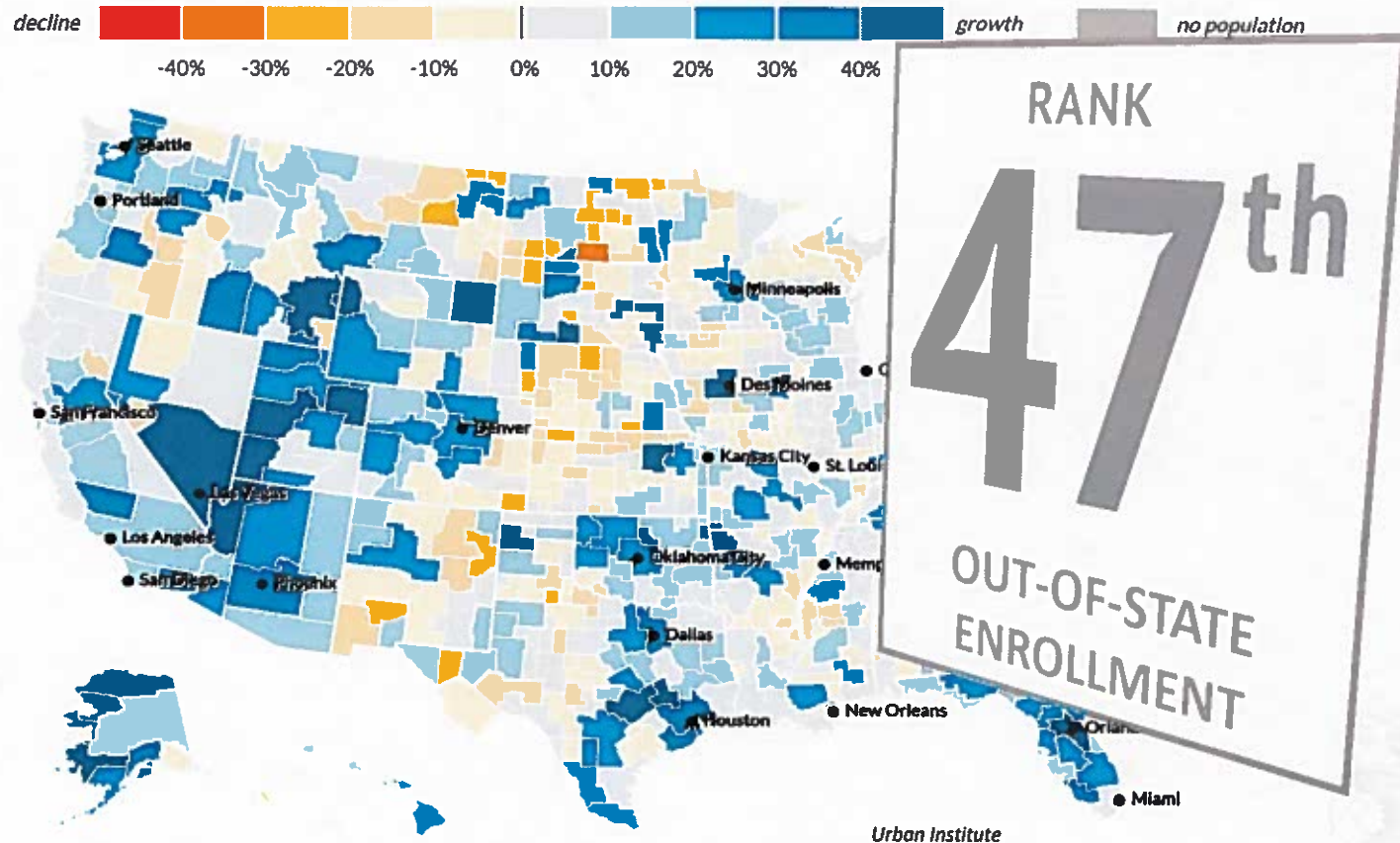
Innovation Capital has a strong correlation with productivity growth
