WASHTENAW COUNTY (Region 9)

Emergency transitional housing program. Grant funding being used for Phase II of a Shipping Container Home Initiative (Wayne County) and the Five Home Rental Program (Washtenaw County). The Shipping Container Home Initiative is a cost-efficient and innovative approach of repurposing shipping containers into homes for transitional housing. The Five Home Rental Program is a collaborative effort with Washtenaw County for the rental of five homes tailored to the needs of veterans for transitional housing, job readiness, and family support with a transition to permanent housing.

GENESEE COUNTY (Region 6)

Homes for heroes, a permanent housing program for veterans offering stable housing and wrap-around services helping veterans and their families regain independence, dignity, and self-sufficiency. Grant funding being used for home renovations. Their program collaborates with MiWorks, and justice involved veterans to support physical and mental health services, employment assistance, legal counseling, and financial literacy programs.

WASHTENAW COUNTY (Region 9)

The RAVEL program (Resources for Assisting Veterans-Emergency and Long-Term) offers immediate relief and support services. It is a collaboration between Chelsea Hospital, Trinity Health Ann Arbor and Trinity Health Livingston working together and with multiple community partners to expand social care services to veterans and their families. The RAVEL program fills a significant housing gap, especially in Washtenaw County. Grant funding being used for immediate relief/support services.

JACKSON COUNTY (Region 9)

A permanent housing model focusing on housing homeless veterans as soon as possible while also offering support services to help veterans remain in their housing. Grant funding used for immediate relief/emergency shelter (hotel rooms) and family support services.

LAPEER COUNTY (Region 6)

Grant funding will be used for a single-family home renovation for one veteran and family.

Project homes addressing housing and supportive service needs for female veterans and their children. The project is expected to increase housing stability, enhance emotional well-being and quality of life, increase financial literacy, and job placement, and develop community support systems. Grant funding used to purchase an apartment building and for renovations.

LENAWEE COUNTY (Region 9)

A Reconnecting Home, a peer run program for veterans in need of temporary housing. The home is a safe space for veterans to receive support while getting back on their feet and forms a "brotherhood" while adjusting back to civilian life. The house provides rooms for 8 veterans and is led by a "house coach." Grant funding used to update and renovate the home.

My Brother's Keeper: \$250,000 Grant

A case management and homeless shelter program in Flint for single men 18 years and older. Grant funding will be used to renovate a new veteran facility, a 19-room house on 10.2 acres.

INGHAM COUNTY (Region 7)

Program to provide employment opportunities for persons with disabilities. Grant funding will be used for a variety of services including support services, immediate relief, and ER shelter (hotels, air bnb rentals, food cards, security deposits, mortgage and rent payments, etc.). to prevent homelessness.
