BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

The current rules provide for the educational, licensure, and continuing education requirements for audiologists. The proposed rule changes would update and clarify definitions, include requirements for human trafficking identification training, remove conflicting language regarding clinical experience requirements, amend licensure requirements for foreign-trained audiologists, update accreditation standards for educational programs, and update other requirements for licensure and relicensure.
