BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Rule set 2018-019 LR would provide for licensure requirements for behavioral analysts, pursuant to 2016 PA 403 and 2016 PA 404. The rule set would add numerous new rules, which would establish basic definitions; requirements for human trafficking identification training; Behavior Analyst Certification Board standards; and re-licensure, license renewal, and license revocation requirements.
