BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Rule set 2015-088 LR would establish a requirement that all persons applying for initial licensure or license renewal to practice as a physical therapist or physical therapist assistant must have completed training in identifying the signs of human trafficking, in accordance with Public Act 343 of 2014, MCL 333.16148.

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES

The rule set would not create any significant fiscal impacts for the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, since tracking the completion of the required training would be included in the existing licensure application and renewal process. The rule set would not have any fiscal impacts on any other units of state or local government.
