BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

The current rules provide for the educational, licensure, and continuing education requirements for chiropractors. The proposed rule changes would update definitions, provide for technical adjustments in the rule set, rescind rules with no statutory basis including ones that pertain to advertising and patient records, update accreditation standards for educational programs, provide for human trafficking awareness training requirements, update requirements for limited licenses and passing exam score, and update other licensure and re-licensure requirements.

2018-016 LR would not cause any change to revenues or expenditures for any unit of state or local government.

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
