BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

2014-002 LR would rescind the entirety of the current rules pertaining to continuing education requirements for physicians and surgeons holding the degree of Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine (D.O.), while the simultaneously promulgated General Rules (2014-001 LR) would replace these rules with revised and renumbered sections updating the continuing education, accreditation, and examination standards, which have not been revised since 1989.
