BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Current rules require disciplinary subcommittees to consider multiple factors when assessing a disciplinary fine for a licensee that has violated the Public Health Code. The department notes that the need for a disciplinary subcommittee to consider each individual factor is not necessary, as many would not be relevant in each particular case. Rescinding the rule would allow disciplinary subcommittees to consider each relevant factor in a case, and not require subcommittees to consider each factor in a set list.

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES

2018-024 LR would not have a fiscal impact on any unit of state or local government.
