BACKGROUND & SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES SUBMITTED TO JCAR

2013-022-LR would amend, add, and rescind rules to adopt, by reference with Michigan-specific amendments incorporated into the rules, the 2015 edition of the International Residential Code (IRC) published by the International Code Council. The proposed rules would bring the rules into conformity with current departmental practices and establish the latest standards pertaining to building, electrical, plumbing, and mechanical practices, products, installations, and inspections. The Stille-DeRossett-Hale Single State Construction Code Act requires the department to revise the rules every three to six years; the rules were most recently revised in 2010 when the 2009 edition of the IRC was adopted.

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES

The rules amended, added, and rescinded by 2013-022-LR would not have a significant direct fiscal impact on the state or local units of government.
