BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

2017-073 LR would amend two existing rules. References contained within the rules would be updated to reference the American National Standards Institute's standards B77.1-2011 and B77.1a-2012, instead of a version of the standards published in 2006. The reference that is being changed relates to safety requirements for passenger ropeways-aerial tramways, aerial lifts, surface lifts, tows, and conveyors. The proposed rule set would also add a provision to an existing rule, requiring that when portions of runs, slopes, or trails are closed that such closures be marked.

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES

The rules amended by 2017-073 LR would not have a fiscal impact on any unit of state or local government.
