BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Rule set 2018-028 LR would update existing rules pertaining to substance use disorder (SUD) programs, which have not been updated in any meaningful capacity since 1981. The existing rule set would be rescinded, then revised and recodified to align with modern standards of practice.

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES

2018-028 LR would have no fiscal impact on the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs. The Department did indicate that government entities that hold SUD licensure would likely realize a reduction in operating costs due to changes made by the rule set.
