BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Current rules allow the Michigan Public Service Commission to establish and enforce quality standards for the provision of unbundled network elements and local interconnection services to providers that are used in the provision of basic local exchange services. Pursuant to the enabling statute, 1991 PA 179, rules concerning service quality promulgated under this act sunset after three years. The proposed rules would renew the aforementioned quality standards for telecommunications service before their expiration in calendar year 2019.

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES

2018-027 LR would not have a significant fiscal impact on any unit of state or local government.
