BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

The department updates the current rule set on an annual basis in order to maintain consistency with the most recent medical indices, billing codes, and fee schedules published by Medicare and other entities. These proposed rule changes would updates dates and references, define telemedicine, update billing procedures for health care professionals, and note a revision in the conversion factor utilized for practitioner reimbursement related to medicine, radiology, and surgical procedures.
