Rebuild Michigan's Water Infrastructure

- Stormwater, Asset Management, Wastewater (SAW Program)
 - \$450 million over 5 years
 - 560 + awards to local communities for asset
 management plans
 - Supported by bonds
 - Funds fully committed in 2018
 - \$62 million reduction in 2019 compared to 2018
- More to be done



Rebuild Michigan's Water Infrastructure

- Proposal
 - Provide funding for asset management and infrastructure improvements
 - Increase fee to 500 + municipal and other drinking water systems providing water to over 1,000 residents
 - Begins in 2020 generating \$25 million and ramps up to \$110 million in 2024
