


# Outcomes from Michigan CCBHC Sites

#### IMPROVED ACCESS TO BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES

An increase in number of youth and adults served, increased services to Mild to Moderate population, and expansion of same day access and crisis services.






### **SERVING MORE WITH LESS**

CCBHSs are currently serving nearly 40% more individuals than at baseline with only 20% more staff. Meanwhile, the reporting CCBHCs had an average of 54 vacancies they were actively recruiting for but could not fill due to continued workforce shortages.



% Increase in 40 the number of 30 persons served 20 compared to the 10 % increase in 10 number of staff







At baseline, CCBHCs averaged one staff person per every 17 people served. Today, the average is one staff person per 20 people served.



### **IMPROVED ACCESS TO SUD SERVICES**

MAT is offered at 85% of clinics and there's been a 128% increase in provision of MAT services. 91% have increased access through adding SUD programs, adding staff competent to serve SUD or expanding capacity of existing programs.








# IMPROVED ACCESS TO PRIMARY CARE

## IMPROVED COLLABORATION WITH LAW ENFORCEMENT

Many CCBHCs collaborate with law enforcement via a CIT model or similar training and partnership.



## INCREASE IN PEER SUPPORT SERVICES

80% of CCBHCs have expanded Peer Services.




# IMPROVED SERVICE FOR VETERANS
