Subject: Michigan Feed Bill Concern

Dear Ag Committee Members,

Diamond V is the manufacturer of a yeast fermentation feed ingredient that is licensed and distributed in most of the 50 states, including Michigan. We have the following concerns with the proposed feed bill that will be heard tomorrow in the Michigan House Committee on Agriculture.

- Section 3. X. (ii) (page 6) (page numbers refer to the attached bill document). As listed, the “labeling” definition deviates significantly from the AAFCO model bill, which covers only “...material accompanying commercial feed.” The Michigan bill states: **(ii) ADVERTISING** or sales literature **ASSOCIATED WITH COMMERCIAL FEED**. We believe that oversight of advertising not accompanying product should be left to the federal agencies, specifically FDA and FTC.
- “Nuisance” on page 32 has no definitions. What will the director use as criteria when enforcing this provision?
