COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

The House Committee on Government Operations was called to order by Chair Sheppard.

The Chair requested attendance be called:

Representative Cole moved to adopt the meeting minutes from September 9, 2020. There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

The Chair laid HB 5981 before the committee:

HB 5981 (Rep. Glenn)

A bill to create the office of the state employee ombudsman; to provide a process for investigating and evaluating reports of suspected violations of law, conduct or decisions that may endanger public health or safety, and gross mismanagement of public funds; to prescribe the powers and duties of the office, the ombudsman, the legislative council, and certain other state agencies and officials; and to prescribe penalties and provide remedies.

Representative Glenn introduced the bill. Questions and discussion followed.

Representative Lilly moved to report out HB 5981 with recommendation. The motion prevailed 5-0-0:

HB 6100 (Rep. Slagh)

A bill to amend 2016 PA 235, entitled "Public threat alert system act," by amending sections 2 and 3 (MCL 28.672 and 28.673).

Representative Cole moved to report out HB 6100 with recommendation. The motion prevailed 3-2-0:
