COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Tuesday, September 15, 2020 10:15 AM Room 352, House Appropriations, State Capitol Building

The House Committee on Tax Policy was called to order by Chair Afendoulis.

The Chair requested attendance be called:

Representative O'Malley moved to adopt the meeting minutes from September 9, 2020. There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

The Chair laid HB 6033, HB 6034 and HB 6035 before the committee:

HB 6033 (Rep. Webber)

A bill to amend 1933 PA 167, entitled "General sales tax act," (MCL 205.51 to 205.78) by adding section 4gg.

HB 6034 (Rep. Lilly)

A bill to amend 1937 PA 94, entitled "Use tax act," (MCL 205.91 to 205.111) by adding section 4gg.

HB 6035 (Rep. Tate)

A bill to amend 1967 PA 281, entitled "Income tax act of 1967," (MCL 206.1 to 206.713) by adding sections 279 and 679.

Representative Webber explained the changes in substitute (H-1) for HB 6033 and substitute (H-1) for HB 6034.

Representative Webber moved to adopt substitute (H-1) to HB 6033. The motion prevailed 15-0-0:
