COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

The House Standing Committee on Appropriations was called to order by the Chair Hernandez.

HB 4830 (Rep. Schroeder) A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code," by amending section 20161 (MCL 333.20161), as amended by 2018 PA 245.
