The Chair laid HB 4366 and HB 4367 before the committee:

HB 4366 (Rep. Sheppard) A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled"

Public health code," by amending section 17744b (MCL

333.17744b), as amended by 2016 PA 384.

HB 4367 (Rep. Sheppard)A bill to allow library employees or agents

to carry and administer opioid antagonists in certain circumstances; to provide access to opioid antagonists by certain libraries and library employees or agents; and to limit the civil and criminal liability of certain libraries and library employees or agents for the possession, distribution, and use

of opioid antagonists under certain circumstances.

The Chair testified in support of HB 4366 and HB 4367.
