The House Standing Committee on Health Policy was called to order by Chairman Vaupel.

The Chair laid HB 4057 before the committee:

HB 4057 (Rep. Marino) A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled "Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"by amending section 221 (MCL 436.1221), as amended by 2018 PA 346.

Representative Marino, along with Barry Szczesny, from Representative Marino's office, testified in

support of the bill.
