The House Standing Committee on Judiciary was called to order by the Chair Filler.

Representative LaFave moved to adopt the meeting minutes from June 4, 2019. There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

The Chair laid SB 23 and SB 24 before the committee:

SB 23 (Sen. Runestad) A bill to prohibit the theft of mail; to provide

for the powers and duties of certain state and local

governmental officers and entities; and to prescribe penalties

and provide remedies.

SB 24 (Sen. Lucido) A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled "The

code of criminal procedure," by amending section 14 of chapter XVII (MCL 777.14h), as amended by 2018 PA 188.

Krista Vincent, from Senator Runestad's office, and Dennis Doherty, representing the Wayne County Prosecutor's Office, explained the proposed substitutes to the bills. Questions and discussion followed.

The Chair laid HB 4411 before the committee:

HB 4411 (Rep. Lilly) A bill to amend 1994 PA 160, entitled

"Credit services protection act," by amending section 3

(MCL 445.1823).
