The House Standing Committee on Judiciary was called to order by Chair Filler.

SB 0029 (Sen. Lucido) A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The

Michigan penal code," by amending section 136b (MCL

750.136b), as amended by 2016 PA 488.

SB 0030 (Sen. Lucido) A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled "The

code of criminal procedure," by amending section 16g of chapter XVII (MCL 777.16g), as amended by 2018 PA 374.
