

Even Exchange Program (Knowledge Test Waiver)

ISSUE: The military does an excellent job training personnel to drive large vehicles. In the civilian sector, personnel who have a military drivers license must go through additional civilian training in order to convert their military skills to civilian skills. This often leads to additional training costs and licensing fees.

SOLUTION: This Federal program allows qualified military drivers to be exempt from the knowledge test for obtaining a CDL. When used in conjunction with the existing Military Skills Test Waiver, this allows a driver to exchange a military license for a Commercial Drivers License.

BENEFITS: Soldiers and Airmen could use a direct military skill that translates into the civilian market, thereby reducing MING underemployment and increasing retention.
