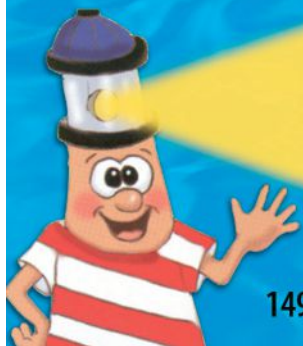

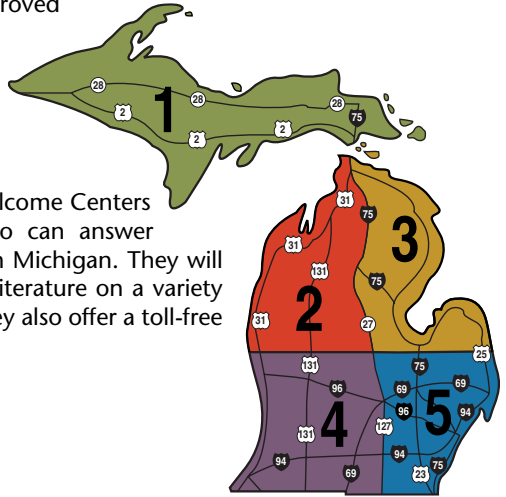

Reservations Are Important • Peak weeks in the summer are from the close of school until Labor Day. During this time most campgrounds encourage reservations and some have minimum requirements for holiday weekends and heavily booked vacation weeks. Although you may find a campsite available if you travel without reservations, we urge you to call ahead if you have certain dates and accommodations in mind. Be sure you understand reservation and refund policies for the campground. These are necessary so the campground can plan appropriately and facilitate other requests. We hope your visit will be pleasurable and that you will return again soon.

Visitor Fees • One of the most perplexing issues in the camping industry today is visitors. Most campers fail to understand why a campground owner requires their visitors to pay a fee for entering and using the facilities. It is not that the campground owner doesn't want visitors, it is simply that the facilities can only handle so many people. Excess people cause strains on restrooms, pools and other facilities. They cause extra utility expenses which have to be paid. They can also add inconvenience to registered campers. Who pays for all this? You the camper? No, the user, the visitor. Please be advised that visitors may be charged a fee for use of the facilities. Thank you.

Pets On Leash • Campgrounds listed in this Directory that are pet friendly understand that pets are part of your family. Unfortunately, there are pet owners who do abuse this privilege. As campers we should be respectful of the campground, our rented sites and our neighbors. Camp Michigan campgrounds are independently owned and operated; therefore, each campground has its own rules for pets. Please check with the individual campground before you make your reservations. 5 TIPS TO ENSURE A GREAT TRIP FOR ALL!

- 1. QUIET HOURS** – Campgrounds will typically post their quiet hours so that everyone can easily see. This is the time when you turn down the music, shout off loud running generators and other equipment. Settle down the kids from running around and bring the noise level at the campfire down to a more peaceful level. If you arrive to the campground during quiet hours, try to be as quiet as possible setting up camp.
- 2. PETS** – Many campgrounds are pet friendly. Not everyone shares the love of your pet as you do. Keeping your dog on a leash at all times is a must. Keep your dogs barking to an absolute minimum. Some parks have rules about leaving pets unattended. Be sure to always clean up after your pets and do not leave dog waste for others to step in.
- 3. FIRES** – Many parks have specific rules regarding campfires. Always check your parks rules. Check rules for transporting firewood. These rules are in place to reduce the spread of bugs and disease that can harm local trees. Do a bit of research before you head out on your trip to see what your campsite's fire rules are. Most importantly, make sure that your fire is completely out before leaving. Do not move fire rings. Do not burn trash.
- 4. CHILDREN** – Set some rules with your kids such as:
 - Don't run into or through someone else's campsite
 - Be careful when riding bikes or scooters through the campground
 - Try to keep voices on the quiet side (this is a must during quiet hours)
- 5. WASTE** – First and foremost, do not litter! Place trash in the proper place and do this often. Some parks will pick up trash, all parks have a trash bin or area for trash disposal. Empty your black or gray water tanks in designated areas. Be sure to make sure all sewer connections are properly secured.
