COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Wednesday, April 21, 2021 10:30 AM Room 352, House Appropriations, State Capitol Building

The House Committee on Tax Policy was called to order by Chair Hall.

The Chair laid SB 25 before the committee:

SB 25 (Sen. Barrett)

A bill to amend 1967 PA 281, entitled "Income tax act of 1967," by amending section 30 (MCL 206.30), as amended by 2020 PA 65.

Tim Langholz, representing the Senator Barrett, testified in support of SB 25. Questions and discussion followed.

Paul Connors, representing the Michigan Department of Treasury, testified with a neutral position on SB 25. Questions and discussion followed.

HB 4221 (Rep. Cavanagh)

A bill to amend 1967 PA 281, entitled "Income tax act of 1967," (MCL 206.1 to 206.713) by adding
