## COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

The House Committee on Transportation was called to order by Chair O'Malley.

The Chair requested attendance be called:

Representative Carra moved to adopt the meeting minutes from September 14, 2021. There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

The Chair laid HB 4997 and HB 4998 before the committee:

HB 4997 (Rep. Sneller)

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code," (MCL 257.1 to 257.923) by adding section 638a.

HB 4998 (Rep. O'Malley)

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code," by amending section 638 (MCL 257.638).

Representative Sneller testified in support of HB 4997 and HB 4998. Questions and discussion followed.

Sergeant Chris Gerard and Lieutenant Lance Cook, representing the Michigan State Police,

testified in support of HB 4997 and HB 4998. Questions and discussion followed.
