Dear Ms. Sweet,

I am writing regarding House Bill 4762. In its current form it aims to prohibit discrimination based on disability status with regard to the organ transplant process. I would like to strongly encourage the committee to add size/weight to this bill. Fat people are frequently discriminated against in medical settings. Obviously, physicians should be able to use their judgement about whether a person is a good candidate, but I strongly believe that blanket policies could be in place that would make it less likely people of size would even be considered for a transplant. Michigan has done a good job protecting people from discrimination in the workplace based on body size (e.g., the Elliott-Larson Civil Rights Act). I believe adding weight/height to Bill 4762 would be consistent with the spirit of Michigan law, and also would serve to protect the lives and health of many Michiganders.
