
The Prosecuting Attorney is an Independent Constitutional Officer.

- Juvenile and family proceedings


"The duty of the prosecutor is to seek justice, not merely to convict." (ABA Standards)

- Expansion of expunctions
- Expansion of HYTA
- Right-sizing of crimes
- Objective parole
- Jail and Pre-trial Task Force



PAAM Priorities for 2021-22

- Protecting victims: providing sentencing certainty, updating crime victims rights act, and revising restitution.
- Review the penal code: repealing unnecessary crimes and revising appropriate penalties.
- Advocate for prosecutor resources: due to need for increasing requests for data, increasing role with treatment courts and Covid-19 trial delays.
- Repeal the .08 sunset.
