### COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Tuesday, April 27, 2021

The House Committee on Judiciary was called to order by Chair Filler.

The Chair requested attendance be called:

Representative Mueller moved to adopt the meeting minutes from April 20, 2021. There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

The Chair laid HB 4627 before the committee:

HB 4627 (Rep. Brixie)

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled "The code of criminal procedure," by amending section 9c of chapter IV (MCL 764.9c), as amended by 2020 PA 393.

Tom Boyd, State Court Administrator, testified with a neutral position on HB 4627. Questions and discussion followed.

1. Amend page 5, line 16, by striking out all of enacting section 1.

Representative Steven Johnson moved to adopt the amendment to HB 4627. The motion prevailed 12-0-1:

Posthumus)	A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law," by amending sections 31, 683, and 730 (MCL 168.31, 168.683, and 168.730), section 31 as amended by 2012 PA 271, section 683 as amended by 2018 PA 120, and section 730 as amended by 1995 PA 261, and by adding section 730a.

HB 4091 (Rep. Whiteford)	A bill to amend 1965 PA 213, entitled "An act to provide for setting aside the conviction in certain criminal cases; to provide for the effect of such action; to provide for the retention of certain

nonpublic records and their use; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain public agencies and officers; and to prescribe penalties," by amending section 1 (MCL 780.621), as amended by 2020 PA 191.

HB 4092 (Rep. Filler)

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled "The code of criminal procedure," (MCL 760.1 to 777.69) by adding section 21d to chapter VIII.

HB 4093 (Rep. Kahle)

A bill to amend 1939 PA 288, entitled "Probate code of 1939," by amending section 18e of chapter XIIA (MCL 712A.18e), as amended by 2020 PA 361.

HB 4214 (Rep. Mueller)

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled "The code of criminal procedure," by amending section 27c of chapter VIII (MCL 768.27c), as added by 2006 PA 79.

Representative Whiteford, Representative Kahle, Chairman Filler, and Representative Mueller, testified in support of HB 4091, HB 4092, HB 4093 and HB 4214. Questions and discussion followed.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code," by amending section 7523a (MCL 333.7523a), as added by 2019 PA 8.

Representative Garza and Chairman Filler, testified in support of HB 4631 and HB 4632. Questions and discussion followed.

Edward Chicko and Thomas Zahina, representing the Wayne County Airport Authority Police, testified in support of HB 4631 and HB 4632.
