




# STEWARDSHIP ON THE HURON-MANISTEE NATIONAL FOREST

- UNITED STATES FOREST SERVICE PROVIDED OVER \$320,000 IN RETAINED RECEIPTS THROUGH AN ONGOING AGREEMENT MATCHED WITH MORE \$84,000 IN PARTNER FUNDING TO CONSERVE/ENHANCE ABOUT 600 ACRES OF IMPERILED OAK SAVANNA HABITAT ON FS LANDS IN WEST MICHIGAN, AS PART OF LARGER EFFORT TO RESTORE 3,000 ACRES.
- AGREEMENT NEARING \$1MILLION IN VALUE





  LEARNING TO STAY ACTIVE IN THE OUTDOORS.






