- Founded in MI, 1959
- "to conserve, protect & enhance coldwater fisheries and the waters that support them"
- 20 local chapters in MI
- $\sim$ 7,500 active members MI
  - 400 chapters in US
- ~200,000 members in US
  - ~225 staff in US
    - Grassroots
  - Science-driven, conservation





- Michigan TU volunteers
  - $\star$  ~50,000 hours annually
  - ❖ Valued at ~ \$1.3 M
- Funds Raised & Spent
  - → ~1.5\$ M annually, varies with the projects completed each year.


