
Who is DU?

- Mission: To conserve, restore, and manage wetlands and associated habitats for North America's waterfowl. These habitats also benefit other wildlife and people.
- Over 650,000 members nationwide, over 28,000 of which are here in MI.
- Conserved over 15 million acres across North America to-date, 87,000 of which are in MI.











Who is DU?

- DU is a science-based organization that makes strategically targeted conservation investments across the landscape.
- Waterfowl are some of the most well researched forms of wildlife, with over 100 years of data from surveys and scientific inquiry.
- Modern day conservation decisionmaking involves utilization of band recovery data, state-of-the-art spatial analysis, waterfowl energetics modeling, and hi-tech tracking techniques







Michigan DU Conservation Program

- Focus is on public lands work; specifically, enhancing and maintaining water control infrastructure on our wildlife areas and refuges.
- Other important elements include private lands work in partnership with USFWS.











- Public/Private partnership to restore an approximately 80-acre parcel for the purposes of Lake Erie water quality.
- Funding from MNRTF and U.S. EPA ~
 \$2.8 million
- DU's spatial analysis narrowed project site possibilities from >20,000 to just 42.
- We anticipate significant progress will be made on site selection, acquisition, and water quality monitoring in CY21.
