## **COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**

		prohibit postsecondary educational institutions in
		this state and certain athletic organizations from
		preventing a college athlete from receiving
		compensation for the use of his or her name,
		image, or likeness rights," by amending sections 9
		and 11 (MCL 390.1739 and 390.1741); and by
		repealing enacting section 1.
