# **COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**

Tuesday, February 1, 2022

The House Committee on Regulatory Reform was called to order by Chair Hauck.

The Chair requested attendance be called:

Representative Mueller moved to adopt the meeting minutes from December 7, 2021. There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

The Chair laid HB 5587 before the committee:

HB 5587 (Rep. Hauck)

A bill to amend 1972 PA 230, entitled "Stille-DeRossett-Hale single state construction code act," (MCL 125.1501 to 125.1531) by adding section 13h.

hemp growers act," by amending section 609 (MCL 333.29609), as amended by 2021 PA 4.

HB 5061 (Rep. Posthumus) A bill to amend 2014 PA 547, entitled "Industrial

hemp research and development act," by amending the title and sections 2 and 7 (MCL 286.842 and 286.847), the title and section 2 as amended by 2018 PA 641 and section 7 as added by 2018 PA 641, and by adding section 11a.

HB 5617 (Rep. Outman) A bill to amend 2000 PA 92, entitled "Food law,"

by amending section 1109 (MCL 289.1109), as amended by 2018 PA 92, and by adding section

7136.
