The House Committee on Regulatory Reform was called to order by Chair Hauck.

The Chair laid HB 5695, HB 5696 and HB 5726 before the committee:

HB 5695 (Rep. Wendzel) A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled "Michigan

liquor control code of 1998," by amending section 707 (MCL 436.1707), as amended by 2008 PA 11.

HB 5696 (Rep. Young) A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled "Michigan

liquor control code of 1998," by amending section 502 (MCL 436.1502), as amended by 2020 PA

112.

HB 5726 (Rep. Outman) A bill to amend 1978 PA 90, entitled "Youth

employment standards act," by amending section

15 (MCL 409.115).
