The House Committee on Regulatory Reform was called to order by Chair Hauck.

The Chair laid HB 5839 before the committee:

HB 5839 (Rep. Outman)

A bill to amend 2018 IL 1, entitled "Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marihuana Act," by amending section 7 (MCL 333.27957).

liquor control code of 1998," by amending sections 105 and 603 (MCL 436.1105 and 436.1603), as

amended by 2021 PA 19.

HB 6107 (Rep. Hoitenga) A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled "Michigan

liquor control code of 1998," by amending section 609a (MCL 436.1609a), as amended by 2020 PA

119, and by adding section 609f.
