Michigan County Road Agencies are ...



Responsible for 75% of Michigan's road miles.

- = 90,210 miles of roads (124,001 total).
 - 27,277 miles of primary roads.
 - 62,933 miles of local roads.
- = 5,724 bridges (11,061 total).
- = Thousands of culverts.


Quick fact: Michigan has the 4th-largest system of local roads in the US.

County Road Agency Revenue

CRA

- 31 countywide road millages.
- Hundreds of township millages.
- Special assessment districts.

County road agencies get state, federal and local dollars. Have no taxing, debt-bonding authority.







What is the County Road Association of Michigan?

Since 1918 ...

- 83 county members.
- Highway Conference meetings 1,000+ attendees.
- 4 special-focus conferences; numerous current issue workshops Unfunded Liabilities.
- 7 staff, contracted engineer.

CRA's mission:

"To help our members promote and maintain a safe, efficient local road system in rural and urban Michigan including appropriate stewardship of the public's right-of-way."



Protecting the Road Right-of-Way



An emphasis on roadways and bridges leaves out an important part of the road infrastructure:

The right-of-way (ROW):


- Created to **ensure driver safety** and ...
- Manage H₂O (ditches) to protect roads.
- Public utilities added in mid-1930s.
- Increasing: Private business pressure (broadband, etc.)!

ROW has **maintenance costs:** Brushing, ditching/re-grading, tree removal.

Also used by ORVs, snowmobiles.


Road Right-of-Way illustrated

CRA's NEW seasonal weight restrictions app






The convenience of seeing road restrictions in the palm of your hand.



Working with industry





What's app? It's free!

- Updated color-coded map.
- List of all-season roads, not just restricted.
- The ability to jump right to **pull permit**.
- Subscribe to be **alerted** when counties make changes in seasonal road status.

Legislative Road Agency Environmental Success Story



MiWB – Michigan Wetland Board

- Bill passed in 2016.
- \$2M/year with \$5M cap.
- Established 16 wetlands in four years.

Bridge Bundling Pilot

- \$23M in federal funds for 19 bridges.
- Road agencies cut red tape.
- MDOT coordinated "like" bridges.
- 14 bridges had wetland impact.
 - All impacts were mitigated in 1 day at \$0 as MiWB filled need.





Innovation in Funding



Since 2017: Federal Fund Exchange

Getting more "bang for the buck" from federal road funds.

Number of trades:

- 2020 17 trades
- 2019 18 trades
- 2018 13 trades
- 2017 5 trades




Job recruitment campaign

Jobs offer:


- Good pay

Crisis Recovery on the County Road System

Environmental disasters wreak havoc on roads, culverts and bridges on a regularly.

- June 2020 Rainstorm-dam break \$5M, Gladwin;
 \$2M, Iosco; and \$28M Midland.
- June 2018 Rainstorm \$30M, Houghton.
- June 2017 Rainstorm \$12M, Isabella and \$7M, Midland.
- July 2016 Rainstorm \$5.5M, Gogebic.
- **September 2013** Rainstorm \$1.4M, Chippewa.





Crisis Recovery on the County Road System




Legislation to establish Transportation Infrastructure Disaster Relief Fund.

CRA has a federal STIC (Statewide Transportation Innovation Council) grant:

- Discussions with MEDC about CDBG Funds for Infrastructure.
- 2) Grant Received by Gladwin CRC to Develop "Hands-on" Resources.
 - a. Crisis-related fiscal preparedness training
 - *b. Video* (30 min.) + e-tools
 - c. Meeting of MI Infrastructure Disaster Response Agencies
 - d. "In the moment" video
- 3) Online/phone consultation with disaster-impacted agency.

Local Bridge Funding Problem





- 5,700 county-managed bridges.
- 1 in 8 structurally obsolete.
 - 400 serious/critical bridges
 - 1,056 load restricted
 - 28 closed in 2019
- FY 2023 = 422 apps for \$305M (limit 5/county).
- Available budget = \$28M (1/2 cent + \$5M).





- Opportunity for MDOT-CRA-MML cooperation
- \$23M fed. funds => 19 bridges (13 counties, 2 cities)
- CRA ID'd 83 "County Bridge Champions"
 - Champions reviewed all bridges in county.
- MDOT let 1 bid for all projects
 - Locals transferred ownership rights to MDOT for project
 - Finished bridge reverts to local ownership




\$900M bond over ____ years is good way to solve Michigan's bridge problem.

CRA survey shows 83% of new funds going to roads bridges and ROW.



NEW! Standardized Permits Revised




CRA's Permit Subcommittee has updated 12 permits all 83 counties are considering.

NEW! E-permitting!


- 24/7, 365 e-access.
- E-pay, e-signature, e-permit.
- Oxcart System (Michigan and Illinois).
- 54 county road agencies using.
- NEW! Regional adoption underway.
- NEW! Work in the right-of-way permit in rollout.
